Getting back to church - Current situation (Phase 3)

- Churches remain open for private prayer this week but these opening hours will cease from Sunday 19th July EXCEPT for the Saturday hours which will be retained for confessions.
- > Starting Saturday 18th July, some Masses will be celebrated with a congregation in the churches (see below)
- Funerals, Weddings and Baptisms can take place in churches from 15th July, with limited numbers attending.

Coming to church for Mass

Rejoice! At last we are able to start celebrating Mass in the churches again, starting in our parish on Saturday 18th July. The Mass schedule for the first week will be as follows:

St John's – Saturday 18th July 6pm; Sunday 19th July 11.30am; Tuesday 21st July 9.30am St Kentigern's – Sunday 19th July 9.30am; Sunday 19th July 5pm; Thursday 23rd July 9.30am

There is a limit of 50 people at each Mass and so we have put a booking system in place.

YOU MUST BOOK A PLACE BEFORE YOU COME TO MASS.

There are two ways to book:

- 1. **Eventbrite** Links to the Eventbrite pages for each church are on the parish website and Facebook page. Follow the links, select the Mass you wish to attend that week ('Select A Date') and select the number of tickets you want to book. Only book multiple tickets for a single household who will sit together. You must enter the name of each individual person in the booking. If you are booking for someone else please make a separate booking for each household. Name and contact details for each booking must be supplied. Booking ends 12 hours before the Mass starts.
- 2. **Telephone** If you do not have internet you can book a place by calling Marlene McCallum on 07748 817878 (10am-8pm). You will be asked to give your name, address and phone number.

Here is what to expect when you come to church for Mass:

- ➤ Volunteers will be at church to welcome and assist you. Please follow their guidance.
- All are asked to wear face-coverings in the church. Please bring your own if you have one. There will be some at church for those who don't have one. Children under 5 years are exempt from wearing face-coverings.
- Please sanitise hands on entry and exit using the dispensers provided.
- A volunteer will guide you to the designated seating which maintains 2m social distancing. <u>Please only sit</u> where the welcomers direct you to.
- Personal lighting of votive candles is not allowed at this time.
- Please follow the one-way system which is indicated by signs when entering and leaving the church.
- ➤ The Liturgy is adapted for brevity so there will be no Gloria, Creed or Bidding Prayers and only one reading before the Gospel. At the end of Mass, Communion will be distributed under one kind, on the hand. After receiving Communion you are asked to leave the church directly.

Those with underlying health conditions requiring shielding and long-term health conditions requiring a flu jag should follow Scottish Government guidelines in deciding whether to come to church or not.

If you have any Covid-19 symptoms (fever, cough, loss of smell or taste), PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE CHURCHES. Thank you for your cooperation.

Mass online – When church Mass begins the online Mass will be streamed at 9.30am on Monday, Wednesday and Friday
