Thank you everyone who has been able to continue with Gift Aid contributions during this pandemic. Some Parishioners are currently in difficult financial circumstances and this is entirely understood.

Sincere thanks to all who have managed to transfer from Envelopes to Online Banking payments. Excellent! Having a regular Parish income is vital, especially when attendance at Mass is so limited in numbers, resulting in significantly reduced Envelope and Plate collections. The good news is that as these changes to online banking are being made, monthly income is recovering.

Envelope Order

At this time of year an order is placed for 2021-2022 Envelopes. In calculating the numbers we require, it is hoped that those of you who have moved from Envelopes, will continue to donate online. Please! It really makes a tremendous difference in reducing administration and assuring the Parish of a regular income, no matter the circumstances. Like your own home, the bills come in, irrespective of income.

Appeal

A number of Parishioners are donating online regularly, who have not signed up for Gift Aid. This is a significant loss of income the Parish could have by you merely filling in a single form. If you are a tax-payer, the Parish can claim a bonus 25% from HMRC on your donations, at no extra cost to yourself.
