Sunday Readings: Our readings today are a particular encouragement to all those who suffer for the sake of their faith. Jeremiah senses himself to be surrounded by evil men disparaging and denouncing him but finds strength in leaning on the Lord who is always at his side ready to deliver him from their clutches. Jesus tells his little band of followers not to be afraid as he sends them out to proclaim the kingdom of God. In worldly terms they face impossible odds as they step out into an unbelieving and hostile environment but he reminds them that they are doing the work of God who knows, loves and cares for them eternally. Considering the eternal glory that awaits those who *commit their cause to the Lord*, earthly toil and strife for the sake of the kingdom are a price worth paying.





This weekend sees the celebration of the Birth of St John the Baptist, one of our parish's Patron Saints. On Thursday we will celebrate the Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul. All three are the finest examples of men who stood up and embraced the Cross for the sake of the Gospel. They gave their all to lead people to Jesus Christ through whom divine grace came to our fallen world as an *abundant free gift*, overturning the reign of sin and death.

Persecution of Christians is widespread and increasing across the world. In the light of these great heroes of faith let us remember and pray for our brothers and sisters around the world who suffer for the sake of Christ. Let us be inspired to commit our own cause to the Lord, come what may.
