**Sunday Readings:** Today we celebrate the great Feast of the Transfiguration. Jesus took Peter, James and John to the top of a high mountain and there revealed to them 'his majesty' and they heard 'the Sublime Glory itself' speak to him according to the testimony of Peter related in the second letter of St Peter. Peter is at pains to say "We saw and heard this! We didn't make it up!" The Gospel recounts the awesome vision granted to the three apostles which offered them a precious glimpse of the heavenly

reality of the divine Son of God whom they have known up to now as the man Jesus. It's as if in reaching the top of the high mountain they have poked their heads into

the throne room of heaven seen in the vision of Daniel in the first reading where 'coming on the clouds of heaven, one like a son of man...came to the one of great age and was led into his presence. On him was conferred sovereignty, glory and kingship.' For the apostles it is a confirmation of the Lordship of the Lord, a glorious vision to bolster their faith and gladden their hearts for the difficult road ahead.
