Sunday Readings: Elijah encounters God on the holy mountain Horeb/Sinai in the sound of a gentle breeze. This is unexpected because on this same mountain Moses and the people of Israel had encountered God amidst thunder, lightning and earthquake. Perhaps this is to make the point that the true God is not to be identified with the physical forces of nature as with so many pagan religions but instead is the commanding presence over and above those forces. In the Gospel, Peter encounters God coming in the unexpected form of Jesus as a commanding presence over and above the stormy waters of the lake. In the middle of the storm, Peter calls out to Jesus and hears him calling back to him, 'Come.' As long as he is focused on Jesus, Peter finds that he too can do the seemingly impossible, walk on water. As soon as he loses focus and is distracted by the storm, he begins to sink. Once again, he calls out to Jesus to save him and he is held above the water. Don't let the storms of life drag you down. Keep your focus on Jesus. Do it every day in the quiet of prayer and you too can withstand the violent winds of trouble. And if you feel yourself going down, cry out to him, 'Lord! Save me!' and know that he will.

<u>Fire Safety Training:</u> In order to keep up with modern health and safety regulations we are obliged to make sure that parish volunteers have some fire safety training as fire safety is seen as everyone's responsibility. The Archdiocese has organised a training session to take place at two times on **Wednesday 23rd August** – 2.00-4.30pm (booking <u>HERE</u>) and 6.30-9.00pm (booking <u>HERE</u>). This Fire Safety training course is provided by Thomson & Inglis Business Solutions. It is aimed at anyone who has (or may have in the future) a role within the parish setting, so this would include Clergy, PPC members, volunteers (including cleaners), pass keepers etc.

Topics covered include Fire Safety Measures (active & passive controls), Safe & Controlled Fire Evacuation Methods, the role of Clergy, Staff and volunteers, and Human Behaviours in emergency situations. Certificates will be issued to all attending and costs will be paid by the parish.

If you volunteer in the parish do please sign up for one of the sessions and please let Fr Jeremy know when you have completed the training.
