<u>Sunday readings</u>: American statesman Benjamin Franklin famously said "In this world nothing can be said to be certain, except death and taxes." In the Gospel today, Jesus makes a clear distinction between what belongs to this world and what belongs to God. Yes, taxes need to be paid but this should be a secondary concern for us because there is much more at stake with the other of life's certainties. Because death is also certain we should be more concerned with making sure that we are offering God what belongs to him, which is, our heart and soul. St Paul reminds us that this means showing your faith in action, working for love and persevering through hope, in our Lord Jesus Christ.

Synod Prayer: Archbishop Cushley encourages us to pray for the success of the Synod of Bishops, which is taking place in Rome throughout October: We stand before You, Holy Spirit, as we gather together in Your name. With You alone to guide us, make Yourself at home in our hearts; Teach us the way we must go and how we are to pursue it. We are weak and sinful; do not let us promote disorder. Do not let ignorance lead us down the wrong path nor partiality influence our actions. Let us find in You our unity so that we may journey together to eternal life and not stray from the way of truth and what is right. All this we ask of You, who are at work in every place and time, in the communion of the Father and the Son, forever and ever. Amen.
