

Scripture Readings: The ten commandments were given to the people of Israel as a rule of life that would keep the people set apart from other nations for the right worship of God and right practice and attitude towards other people and the goods of the world. The first and most important commandment is that the people shall have no other gods except the one, true God of heaven and earth. Jesus' anger at the sellers in the temple is directed at their idolatry. They have made a god out of commerce and money and profaned the temple by setting their idol up there.
