Easter Appeal: Towards the costs of replacing the rotten windows on the west side of St Kentigern's church. As I have mentioned, the extent of the damage was found to be much more severe than originally thought and the estimate for replacing

the windows is in excess of £80,000. In line with Archdiocesan policy we are seeking with this appeal to raise 15% of the project cost (ca. £12,000). The appeal is to the whole parish, recognising that we are one and that together we must look to maintaining all the buildings across the parish.
