**Sunday Reading:** Jesus offers his body and blood as real food and drink that sustain us on our journey through life. His body and blood, given up for us on the cross and glorifed at the resurrection, are given to us in the form of bread and wine, as he instructed the apostles at the last supper. Jesus says, "Whoever eats me will draw life from me". Through Holy Communion we assimilate the life of

heaven and are called to live lives that serve to redeem the "wicked age" of the times in which we live. This last part is important. At the end of each Mass, having shared Holy Communion, the congregation is commissioned and blessed to "Go, and announce the Gospel of the Lord"; or to "Go

in peace, glorifying the Lord by your life." Unless for very good reason to do with health or urgent need, it is quite wrong to leave Mass before receiving the commission and final blessing.
