A message from Fr Jamie: Friends, it's definitely feeling very autumnal in these day - I hope that you enjoyed the extra hour in bed that marks the end of 'summertime' this weekend. In the Church's liturgy too, there are signs of a change in the season. In the coming weeks leading up to Advent, the Church invites us to think about the 'last things' – not so much doom-laden predictions that 'the end of the world is nigh' (although it might be!) but rather an eager, hopeful summons to prepare to meet Christ our King when he comes in the glory of his saints. This Friday's celebration of 'All Saints' reminds us of the friendship of the Church in heaven and our November prayers for the faithful departed speak to our enduring connection to our beloved dead, with bonds of reciprocal help that reach beyond the grave and into eternity. As you'll note from the above, the weekly Mass schedule is a little different this week – we're delighted to welcome the children from St Andrew's Primary for All Saints' day at 10am in St John's (note later start to accommodate the walk!) and there will be an additional evening Mass in St Kentigern's for those who're working during the day.
