A message from Fr Jamie: Friends, Advent is one of my favourite seasons of the year – in these weeks running up to Christmas the Church focusses our attention on encountering Jesus – as he comes to us as a baby at Christmas time, as he comes to us in glory at the end of time and as he comes to us in the in-between in his Word and his Sacraments. I've been reading recently the Advent sermons of the German Jesuit priest Fr Alfred Delp, executed for his opposition to Nazism – he says that "when the Church puts on purple vestments, she asks us to think about serious things!" This notwithstanding, may these preparations for Christmas be full of joyful hope and rich in blessings for all of us! As you know, this weekend we're using the new lectionary for the first time. Bishop Hugh Gilbert, the outgoing president of the Bishops' Conference of Scotland, said that the new lectionary might feel, at first, a little like a new pair of shoes: smart and shiny, but maybe a little stiff and uncomfortable while we get used to it. My own hope is that it will spark our curiosity and help us to hear the word of God in a new way! You might be interested in taking part in a Zoom series I'm doing for the Archdiocese's Commission for Catechetics, which will take 'a closer look' at the language of the new translation: sign up at bit.ly/lectionaryadvent
