A message from Fr Paul: In the Gospel reading this Sunday, we read Luke recounting to his patron, Theophilus, the beginning of the story of Jesus. It is interesting that the name Theophilus translates from the Greek as 'the lover of God' and some scholars speculate that Luke has created the name to stand for all people reading the Gospel, all of us, who are lovers of God. If we reflect over our lives, we can discover that there was one point when we started following Jesus, when we began to be lovers of God. For many of us I imagine, it started like a tiny seed, a sense of a glimmer of hope, of truth, of love, when we heard about the life and sayings of Jesus. Perhaps we can even remember the surroundings or the people around us when this happened, the first conscious realisation when we thought "this is true" or "this is truly good and beautiful, this is the way I want to try and live my life".

How moving is it to consider the Gospel writer Luke, 2000 years ago, coming to this point, perhaps after hearing St Paul speak about Jesus. Whatever it was, it motivated Luke enough to start on his great enterprise of writing his Gospel and the Book of Acts, a huge undertaking when writing was an extremely expensive and laborious task. Yet the riches he has left us all originate in the first small moment when Luke heard about Jesus and thought "this is the truth!"

The moment I came to this realisation was many decades ago and led me, as a newly ordained priest, to St John's and St Kentigern's parish five months ago. I could not have had a better introduction to priesthood. I have experienced such warmth and love from this congregation, something I will take with me on my journey to Broxburn. I want to thank everyone for the way you have supported my faith in Jesus, who is truly Our Lord and Saviour.
