My dear People of God, as we gather on this 6th Sunday of Easter, the joy of the Resurrection still fills our hearts. Christ is risen, and with each passing week of Easter, we are drawn deeper into the mystery of His victory over death and His promise of New Life. Today's readings remind us not only of the gift of God's abiding love, but also of the promise of something more—something greater still to come.

In the Gospel today, Jesus speaks tenderly to His disciples about love and obedience, and above all, the coming of the Advocate, the Holy Spirit: "Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him, and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him" (John 14:23). Jesus is preparing His followers for a future without His physical presence—but not a future without His love or guidance. His words are full of assurance: they will not be left orphans.

This Sunday sits on the threshold of the Ascension, which we will celebrate this coming Thursday. The Ascension is not a departure in sorrow, but a transition into a new and empowering presence of Christ in the Church. It marks the moment when Jesus entrusts His mission to His disciples—and to us. He ascends not to abandon, but to uplift; not to leave us, but to reign in glory and send the Spirit to animate His Body on earth.

For us, as a parish community, these days call us to awaken more fully to our mission. Like the first disciples, we are called to carry the Gospel into the world, guided by the Holy Spirit. We are not alone. In our joys, our struggles, our acts of service, our celebrations of the sacraments—*Christ is with us*.

As we look ahead to the Ascension, let us remember – we are a people of hope, rooted in the Resurrection and empowered for mission. Let our hearts be stirred by the love of God that dwells within us. Let our parish be a sign of that love, welcoming, vibrant, and joy-filled.

This week, may we pray with anticipation for the coming of the Holy Spirit. May we rise with Christ in hope, as we prepare to lift our eyes to heaven, not only in longing for where He went, but in readiness to do what He asks – *to be a Pilgrim of Hope – to live in Hope and instil Hope in others!*
