My dear People of God, On this Third Sunday of Advent, the Church invites us to pause and rejoice. **Gaudete**—meaning "**Rejoice**!"—breaks through the purple of waiting with a rose-coloured reminder that the Lord is near! Even in a world marked by burdens, uncertainties, and fatigue, today's liturgy announces a profound truth: **joy is still possible, because God is still coming.**

In the Gospel, John the Baptist—imprisoned and uncertain—sends disciples to ask Jesus, "Are you the one who is to come?" Jesus responds not with theories, but with signs of hope: the blind see, the lame walk, the deaf hear, the dead are raised. In other words: **new life is already breaking in**. This is the quiet but unstoppable joy of the Kingdom.

We, too, may carry questions like John's. Is God really listening? Will He act? Does hope still make sense? Gaudete Sunday answers with a gentle but firm yes. Joy in the Christian life is not a shallow positivity or an escape from reality; it is rooted in the certainty that *God is faithful*, working even in hidden ways. Joy grows wherever Christ is welcomed

St. Paul encourages us: "Be patient... Establish (Strengthen) your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand." Advent joy is born from patience—a trust that God's timing is perfect—and from courage, the willingness to keep loving, serving, and believing even in small daily ways.

As a parish community, we can embody Gaudete joy by noticing the blessings in our midst: families praying together, parishioners serving quietly, children learning the faith, generosity poured out for those in need. These are signs that Christ is already among us.

May this Sunday rekindle in us a joyful expectation. As we light the rose candle, may our hearts, too, glow with hope. The Lord is near—near to our struggles, near to our dreams, near to our parish.

Rejoice, for God comes to bring light, healing, and peace. Come, Lord Jesus!
